Family planning offered in the first year postpartum provides an

opportunity to meet the needs of women who want to prevent unintended pregnancies or who want to delay having more children. Yet, globally, nearly 65% of women in their first postpartum year have an unmet need for family planning services.

We reviewed existing evidence of the efficacy of postpartum family planning interventions targeting women in the 12 months postpartum period in low- and middle-income countries. We searched for studies from January 1, 2004 to September 19, 2015, using the US Preventive Services Task Force ...

meeting the family planning and reproductive health needs of women in the postpartum period. Interventions are designed to complement those of the ACCESS Program in the promotion and scale-up of postpartum family planning through community and clinical interventions.

Postpartum family planning is the initiation and use of family planning methods in the first six weeks following delivery (Figure 11.1). The aim is to prevent unintended pregnancy, particularly soon after childbirth, when another pregnancy could be harmful to the health of the mother or breastfeeding baby.

Provides care during pregnancy, labor and delivery, and postpartum (after delivery) Provides family planning and contraceptive counseling. Orders and interprets laboratory and imaging tests and prescribes medications.

It is recommended that programs implementing immediate postpartum family planning include the following indicators: Number/percent of women who delivered in a facility and received counseling on family planning prior to discharge (disaggregated by age group, <20 years vs. ≥20 years).
